CCB donors are recruited from top

universities across the country (such as UCLA, USC, Stanford, Harvard, and MIT)* as well as the major metropolitan cities surrounding them. Post-graduate donors include established professionals in various fields including business, medicine, law, and the entertainment industry.

Most importantly, CCB provides quantity

without sacrificing quality. Our strict donor qualification process admits less than 1% of all applicants into our program. The use of high educational and physical standards, multiple semen analyses and blood testing, careful evaluation of personal and family medical history, genetic screening, and a series of extensive, in-depth interviews enables CCB to provide the highest caliber donors possible.

CCB recruits donors via internet advertising,

information seminars, and university publications. To apply, donor applicants must complete an online application followed by a 3 to 6 month qualification process.


Basic requirements to apply:

- Age 19 to 39
- Enrolled in or graduated from a four-year university
- Minimum height of 5'9"
- In good health

DONOR QUALIFICATION PROCESS



*Testing performed on all donor applicants: chromosome analysis; carrier screening for cystic fibrosis, spinal muscular atrophy, sickle cell anemia and thalassemia. Testing performed on donor applicants with Jewish ancestry: carrier screening for Bloom syndrome, Canavan disease, familial dysautonomia, Fanconi anemia group C, Gaucher disease, mucolipidosis type IV, Niemann-Pick disease type A and Tay-Sachs disease. Testing performed on donor applicants with French-Canadian ancestry: carrier screening for Tay-Sachs disease.

SELECTING YOUR DONOR Why is CCB so picky about our

donors? Choosing a sperm donor is one of the most important decisions you will ever make. Our high standards assure that every possible step has been taken to protect the health and well-being of you and your future baby.

Anonymous vs. Open Donor

Open Donors agree to one contact with any 18 year-old offspring. CCB will make every attempt to facilitate a meaningful contact. However, there may be situations where a contact between the donor and offspring cannot be established.

CCB will also contact Anonymous Donors on behalf of any 18 year-old offspring. Historically, Anonymous Donors have been very receptive to contact. DONOR INFORMATION:

Long Profile

Our Long Profile contains a three-generation family medical history. We strongly encourage reviewing the long profile before making your final donor choice.

Audio Interview

Audio Interviews are available for most of our donors. The interview allows you to hear a donor's voice as he responds to specific questions. Many CCB parents save the audio interview for their child to hear in the future. You may download the Audio Interview or receive it on CD via mail.

Baby Photo

CCB offers a Baby Photo between the ages of 6 months and 4 years for most donors. Photos are available on our website for download or as 5 x 7 prints via mail. Please note that the quality of the baby photo varies depending on the original photo and may be in color or black and white.

Keirsey Temperament Sorter

The Keirsey Temperament Sorter is a widely used personality test available for many CCB donors. Clients receive a 10 page report, which may provide interesting insight into your own child's temperament someday.

Handwriting Analysis (Graphology)

Handwriting analysis, or graphology, is based in psychology and offers a unique perspective into an individual's emotional development, maturity, and core values.

Facial Features Report

The Facial Features Report includes illustrated examples of facial features in 10 key areas.

Cord blood banking is a valuable asset in protecting the future health of your child. Located in the umbilical cord and placenta, these unique cells are the building blocks of the blood system and may be used instead of a difficult and painful bone marrow transplant to treat certain anemias, leukemias, lymphomas and genetic disorders. To date, there have been over 12,000 successful cord blood stem cell transplants primarily on infants and children, but ongoing research shows promise for additional applications including the treatment of diseases such as Alzheimer's and Parkinson's.

Parents should consider storing their child's cord blood especially if the family has a genetic predisposition for certain conditions or if both genetic links to the parents are not available, as in the case of using a sperm donor. Make sure to have the **Authorization for Release of Semen (A1)** signed by your physician so that you may schedule your vial delivery. From the My Account page, click the Account Information link, then the Physician tab and follow the instructions to have the A1 faxed directly to your physician or download the form and bring to his/her office yourself.

Schedule your FedEx **shipment** online (or by phone at 866-9-CRYOBANK). Plan for your vials to be delivered 24-48 hours prior to your insemination to ensure that they arrive on time. Select a vial storage option. Plan for the future using our **Family Today & Family Tomorrow** free storage plans. Donors often sell out, so be sure to store extra vials while they are available.

- Intrauterine Insemination (IUI) specimens (washed prior to freezing)

Specimen Categories

- Premium Standard for traditional insemination procedures.
- Assisted Reproductive Technology (A.R.T.) - Designed for use in a variety of technologies such as in vitro fertilization (IVF), intracytoplasmic sperm injection (ICSI), GIFT, and ZIFT. Since fewer sperm are required for A.R.T. procedures, vials contain fewer total motile cells.
